Curriculum Information

Al Ain British Academy teachers the National Curriculum for England and Wales, commonly known worldwide as "The British Curriculum". It is separated into stages: Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) for ages 3-5; Key Stage 1 (Years 1 and 2) and Key Stage 2 (Years 3 to 6). Key Stage One for Year 1 and Year 2 pupils; Key Stage Two for the upper primary school (year 3 to year 6). Key Stage Three and Four make up the Secondary School (Year 7 to Year 11) where pupils complete their iGCSE qualifications. Children Aged 16+ then move onto Sixth Form to complete their A-level exams, one of the most prestigious recognized educational certificates in the world.

The National Curriculum Core subjects are: English, Mathematics and Science. Foundation subjects are Design and Technology; Information and Communication Technology; History; Geography; Modern Foreign Languages (Year 3 upwards); Music; Art and Design; Physical Education and Personal, Health and Social Development.

Due to Ministry of Education regulations in the United Arab Emirates, Religious Education is not taught. Arabic, Islamic Studies and Social Studies are taught as per UAE Ministry of Education guidelines. DAD ACAD
