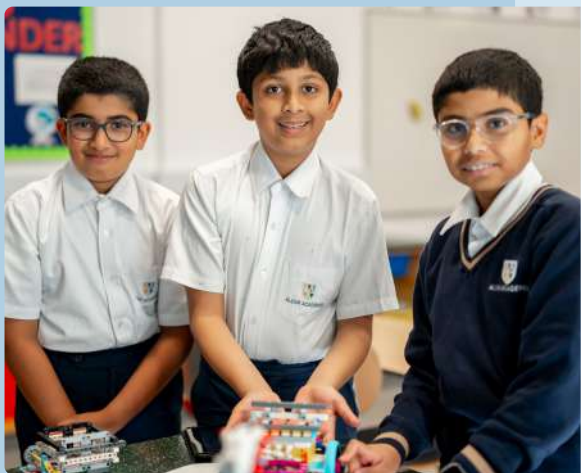
THE CURRICULUM

The Curriculum: At Al Ain British Academy (AABA), we deliver the English National Curriculum from the Early Years Foundation Stage through to Sixth Form, is among the most in-demand study options the world, respected for its high academic standards and focus on developing confidence and individual thinking. The learning pathway is delivered through a method of teaching which inspires a love of learning and deepens a student's knowledge by challenging them to complete real-world tasks. As a result, the English National Curriculum is one of the most engaging of all.

In **Primary**, our students build strong foundations in English, Mathematics, and Science, alongside Computing, Humanities, Creative Arts, French, Physical Education, PSHE, and UAE Ministry subjects (Arabic, Islamic Studies, and Social Studies), with a strong emphasis on leadership, wellbeing, and character development through our hidden curriculum.

In **Secondary**, students' progress through Key Stage 3 (Years 7-9), Key Stage 4 (Years 10-11, IGCSEs), and Key Stage 5 (Years 12-13, IGCSE & A-Levels), combining compulsory subjects with guided choices across Science, Business, Humanities studies, ICT, Art, Drama, French, Spanish, Music, Psychology, and more. Our results place us among the very best schools in the UAE, with 2024 graduates achieving the highest marks in the world in A-Level History and the highest marks in the UAE in IGCSE Physics, Chemistry, and Further Mathematics, in addition to regional top awards in English and Geography.

AABA alumni now study at leading universities worldwide, including the University of Cambridge, King's College London, The London School of Economics, Pennsylvania State University, and NYU Abu Dhabi, pursuing diverse fields such as Medicine, International Relations, Business, Economics, and Politics. Guided by our values of Respect, Responsibility, and Resilience, we prepare our students not only for academic success, but for life.



EXAM SUCCESS

In 2024 - 2025, Al Ain British Academy recorded outstanding GCSE and A Level results, with 32% of GCSEs at grade 9 and 76% at grades 9 - 7. For A Levels, 56% achieved A - A* and 74% at A - B*. Our students consistently secure places at prestigious universities globally underlining the school's commitment to nurturing future-ready global learners.
